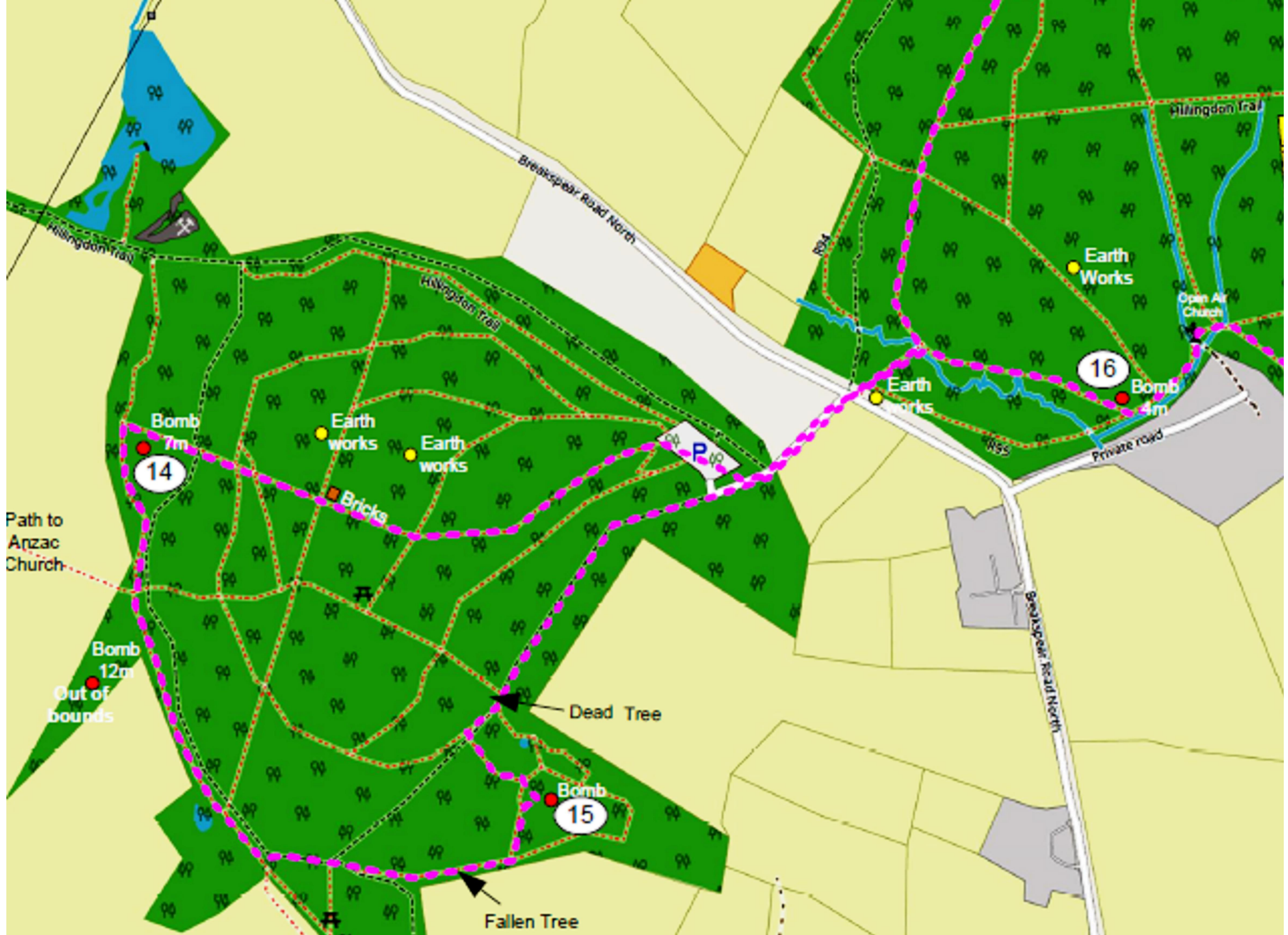

Bomb crater clues

1. Enter the woods by the clubhouse, turn right on the outer path and go up the second path on the left.
2. From 1 go up the path and turn right at the path crossing. It's on the left.
3. Continue down the path from 1, pass the sink hole on the right, and cross over the main track. Follow the path over the "Pale Mound" from History Quest and go down either the centre or left path to the stream. Cross the stream and follow path heading down to King College. It's on the right.
4. Really close to 3 just a little further along on the right.
5. Leaving 4 cut straight across to the main track coming up from Kings College. Go up the track and turn it right. It's a short distance along the path on the right.
6. Follow the paths as shown crossing over the open area and heading to the fence corner for Grangewood School. Turn left and then fork right. It's on the right. It's near to a burnt out motorbike on the side of the path.
7. Is tricky to find. It is two paths over from the Horse ride. This path is quite faint as it goes to nowhere. The easiest way to get on the right path is follow the route on the map.
8. Cut across from 7 to the main path that runs parallel to the Horse ride and climb up the hill. At the top near St Vincent's turn left and then right by a wooden bench and take the path straight down the hill pass the fallen tree and turn right on the next path. It's right next to the path in the bowl area.
9. A bit tricky. Go around the end of the Lido and out onto the common and turn left down the old Met League Bostik Alley path. About halfway along are three oak trees and a holly bush on the right. Walk into the undergrowth and the crater is behind and under the furthest tree.
10. This one is easy. Cross the common and go through the gate and up the hill. Just before the path bends to the left there is a big crater on the left.
11. From 10 go up to the corner of Battle of Britain house garden is and turn right. Take the next left turn and look carefully as it's on the left.
12. From 11 take the second turning on the left down through the high Ferns. Just before the end of the path the crater is on the left.
13. Follow the main track up towards the Horse Crossing. There's a big crater 30 yards in off the main path.
14. Get yourself over to Bayhurst via Mad Bess. Go through the car park and up the path until you find the pile of bricks of the ruined building. Now head straight down crossing over the Horse Ride and it is a few meters in on the left before you get to the outer path.
15. This one's a bit tricky to find. Follow the outer path and ignore the bomb crater that is inside the fenced wooded area. Come out onto the Horse Ride passed the main track back to Mad Bess and then fork left. There is a fallen tree across the path you need go around. Just after it there is a path on the left, go up it and look to your right. You need to go into the undergrowth to get to this one.
16. Back to Mad Bess. Enter the wood and cross the stream and turn right. At the end of the path on the left.
17. Now head to the Six Bells pub. As you come out of the wood passing the swing gate go around the back of the trees and bushes. There is a very large crater under the trees.
